Stunting is by far South Africa's biggest hunger phenomenon in Early childhood development.

STUNTING



1.7m children under 5 years old are stunted in RSA.

Stunting is an abnormally low height for age. It permanently affects a child's physical & cognitive development.

WASTING



An estimated 100 000 children under 5 years old in RSA are wasted.

Wasting is low weight for height. It is life threating for a child.

OVERWEIGHT



An estimated 800 000 children under 5 years old are overweight.

Overweight is high weight for height. It affects a child's health and quality of life.
